Important Notice on Re-entry into Japan
for Border Security Measures
to prevent the spread of Novel Coronavirus

On 11th January 2022, the Government of Japan has decided to allow the re-entry into Japan from Angola, Botswana, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Eswatini, Lesotho, Malawi, Mozambique, Namibia, South Africa, Zambia or Zimbabwe as follows;

The re-entry into Japan of foreign nationals with status of residence who have stayed in aforementioned countries within 14 days prior to the application for landing will be permitted again from 0:00am (JST) on 12th January, 2022.

(Note) With regard to the new entry of foreign nationals from aforementioned countries, those who are acknowledged to have special exceptional circumstances by Japanese authorities may enter Japan even if they have stayed in those countries within 14 days prior to the application for landing into Japan, with a condition that they should possess a valid visa issued by Japanese overseas establishments.

We would deeply appreciate it if your team could notify all related airlines that they should inform all concerned passengers of those measures in order for them to avoid any inconvenience arriving in Japan.
